J Mattravers

Professional Development Plan – J Mattravers reviewed the professional development plan that she and C Ivie proposed after reviewing options with Great Hearts, Ridgeview, National vendors and local vendors. J. Mattravers noted that the Board approved working with Great Hearts to plan professional development, but after reviewing options, it became clear that the budget would not support the comprehensive plan that either Ridgeview or Great Hearts proposed. After speaking with Core Knowledge and Singapore Math vendors and others, C Ivie contacted P Schunk at Ridgeview and spoke with her about mentoring options. The option proposed allows half of our teachers to attend a summer academy at Ridgeview and all of our teachers to be paired with a mentor from Ridgeview that they can continue to work with for the next several years. J Mattravers and C Ivie reviewed all of the other elements of the plan and answered questions about the budget and the overall plan.

L McRae suggested the Board consider approving \$12,000 and then another \$8000 contingent on the State of Idaho receiving the next cycle of grant funding through the Idaho Charter Start grant program.

K Benjamin made a motion to approve the expenditure of \$12,000 for professional development immediately and an additional \$8000 if the second year of charter start funding is received by the State. B Fly – seconded; all.

Building Supplemental Contract – L McRae has been working with C Wright on a supplemental contract due to the development company working with investors – the bank is asking for this supplemental contract – L McRae will continue to provide the Board with updates.

C Ivie

Reformatted Uniform Policy – C Ivie explained that the changes in the actual uniform policy are very minor – the primary change is the formatting so that the policy is easier to understand. C Ivie explained that H McRae and C Davidson spent significant amount of time creating a good policy and really tried hard to make it reasonable and easy to understand. The proposed changes are changes to make it easier to understand – and C Davidson, H McRae and C Ivie worked together to make the changes. L McRae noted that he hopes the Board will not consider making future changes because consistency in this policy is very important.
