ATHLETES EXPECTATIONS

Academic Achievement

To be academically eligible for athletics: a student must be passing all subjects. Failure to meet the HCCS academic eligibility requirements will result in inability to participate in competitions. Students may continue to participate in practices. No refunds are given.

Field/Court Conduct

Athletes should project an image of poise and respect.. Athletes are expected to show respect and sportsmanship during all sporting events.

Attendance

Students must be in attendance at school for a full day in order to participate in any competition. In emergencies/extraordinary circumstances, the principal may waive this rule.
