## Classroom Supply Lists 2016-2017

### KINDERGARTEN

Backpack (See School Handbook)  
4 boxes of crayons, (box of 24).  
2 – 4 oz. Bottles white glue, (orange cap recommended).  
8 glue sticks  
7 - 2 **pocket plastic folders with prongs** . (1 blue, 3 green, 3 red).  
12 # 2 pencils. (Please get the Ticonderoga brand, these do not break so easily and last longer.)  
1 box of washable markers.  
1 box of colored pencils  
2 watercolors  
1 box of kleenex  
Last name beginning with A-M, 1 pack white construction paper  
Last name beginning with N-Z, 1 pack multiple colors construction paper.  
2 Clorox disinfectant wipes.  
2 **composition** wide ruled notebooks (these are not the wire, spiral bound note books)  
1 Pair of Scissors  
A-M 1 Box of sandwich bags  
N-Z 1 Box of gallon size plastic

### SECOND GRADE

Backpack (See School Handbook)  
1 spill proof Water bottle (Optional)  
**Shared Supplies (do not label)**  
48 #2 Ticonderoga pencils  
2 large boxes of tissues (200 count)  
2 glue sticks  
1 package Index Cards  
1 Pkg. Clorox or Lysol wipes (**BOYS**)  
1 Bottle of Hand Sanitizer (**GIRLS**)  
**Individual Supplies: (Label with name)**  
1 plastic pencil box  
1 box Crayola crayons  
1 box Crayola colored pencils  
2 pink pearl eraser  
1 pair of Fiskars or Fiskars-type scissors for kids (3” or 5”, rounded tip)  
3 plastic horizontal-pocket folders any solid color (label each folder with full name)  
2- five subject notebooks  
**No markers or three-ring binders please.**  
\*\*Please keep in mind that items for projects may be requested throughout the year & if a notebook is filled up your student may need another one to finish the year\*\*

### FOURTH GRADE

1 pair of scissors  
10 glue sticks  
5 blue pens  
4 pack slender dry erase markers  
1 old sock or piece of fabric for erasing  
Colored pencils  
1 package of Dry Expo Markers  
Spanish/English Dictionary (Can be purchased at Staples for \$2)  
Multiplication flashcards (for home use)  
**Shared Supplies (Do Not Label)**  
2 containers of Sanitizer wipes  
2 boxes of tissues  
**OPTIONAL:**  
**Students with last name begins with A-L: Cardstock packet (any color)**  
**Students with last name begins with M-Z: 1 Box of sandwich- sized Ziploc bags**

### FIRST GRADE

Back pack (NO LOGOS- Plain as possible)  
**Shared Supplies (do not label)**  
24 **TICONDEROGA** pencils  
2 boxes of crayons – 24-count  
2 large pink erasers  
6 regular sized glue stick  
1 red plastic coated vinyl folder  
1 blue plastic coated vinyl folder  
4 Dry-Erase markers (black only, chisel tipped)  
1 large box of tissues (Kleenex)  
1 pkg. disinfecting wipes (Clorox)  
Student's whose last name begins with A-O: 1 ream of cardstock (110 weight) any color **NOT WHITE** (about 150 sheets in a ream)  
Student's whose last name begins with K- R: 1 box of gallon-sized zippered bag – 20 bags (freezer weight or heavy duty)  
Student's whose last name begins with P-Z: 1 box of sandwich bags  
**Art Supplies (Label with name)**  
1 set of watercolor paints  
1 pkg. colored pencils – 12-count  
1 pkg. **washable** markers – 8-count

### THIRD GRADE

**Do not put your name on the following items, these will be turned in to your homeroom teacher:**  
Community Items  
4 (12 pack) packages of pencils. (Students will keep two packages in their pencil box, two packages will go to Spanish class.)  
2 pink pearl erasers  
2 large boxes of Kleenex  
Clorox wipes  
1 package of colored pencils  
Pencil Box or Bag  
Small personal pencil sharpener  
1 Package of Dry Erase Whiteboard markers (turn two markers in to the Spanish teacher and keep two markers in your pencil box)  
**Put your name on the following items:**  
7 spiral notebooks (4 for Spanish, 3 for English)  
Package of pencil eraser toppers.  
1 homework folders (one for Spanish)  
6 colored plain folders no pictures ( blue, yellow, purple, green, and orange, red for English)  
Spanish/English Visual Dictionary (These need to be comprehensive dictionaries with photos such as: The FireFly Spanish/English Junior Visual Dictionary, Oxford Spanish/English Visual Dictionary or McGraw Hill's Spanish Dictionary. You can usually find a good deal on Amazon. Preferably not My First Spanish dictionary from Scholastic or Spanish First Words.)  
Backpack (See School Handbook)  
**No ink pens or mechanical pencils.**  
Students will have projects throughout the year **in** both English and Spanish. Students will be expected to use poster boards and other materials.

### FIFTH GRADE

Backpack (See School Handbook)  
**Shared Supplies (do not label)**  
4 dozen #2 Ticonderoga pencils (no mechanical pencils)  
2 large boxes of tissue  
2 containers of Sanitizer wipes  
1 - 400 count loose leaf college ruled paper  
7 Composition Notebooks (NO SPIRALS)  
Pocket folders (2 red, 2 blue, 1 green and 1 yellow)  
1 quart size box of zip lock bags  
**Individual Supplies (label with name)**  
2 boxes of 12 colored pencils  
2 packages dry erase markers  
1 multi-pack pens (4 different colors – no clickers)  
2 large glue sticks  
1 Pair of pointed scissors  
1 – 1 ½” three-ring binder (zippered binders work well)  
1 pencil box  
1 Student Agenda  
Tab dividers (sets of 6)  
1 Spanish/English Dictionary (Can be purchased at Staples for \$2)
