School Schedule:

7:30 a.m.- Doors Open (Students may arrive any time after 7:30am. Breakfast is served starting at this time.)

7:55 a.m.- First Bell (This bell signals students to line the school for students to fill their water bottles. up outside in their designated location.)

Pick-Up and Drop-Off Procedures:

AM/PM Pick-Up: NEW PARKING LOT FLOW. The purpose for the change is safety first and to improve traffic flow. Parents enter through the east end of the lot into the 2-lane parent pickup area. Please stay in the car lane. All students will exit the building at 3:00 pm and walk to the designated waiting area.

Please be prepared to give your students name to our staff members running traffic flow standing at the crosswalk area. They will then radio for your child to come to the crosswalk landing area to be directed by staff to your car. Students should be picked up promptly after school. The inner lane is blocked off to traffic flow. The lane closest to the building is designated for buses only.
